REGISTRATION: - Friday 6th April - 16h00 to 19h00 - Saturday 7th April - 09h00 to 12h00

### **SCHEDULE OF RACE:**

- Friday 6th April : Training 15h00 à 17h00.

- Saturday 7th April: 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal at 13h45, Aperitif welcome lunch after the races,

- Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> April: 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal at 10h00,

- Monday 9<sup>th</sup> April: 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal at 10h00.

1.- Authority: The Club Nautique de Saint Raphaël organized from 7th to 9th April 2012, the Euro Cup Tempest 2012 – EC1.

## 2.- Rules :

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009/2012, this notice of race, the class rules (2012 class adhesion is required), the sailing instructions, the FFVoile regulations and the prescriptions applying to foreign competitors. The French text will take precedence.

#### 3.- Official diner:

Official dinner is organized on Sunday 8th April at 20h00 at Saint-Aygulf (Reservation before the 07 April 2012) Price is **25 euros** per person.

#### 4.- Entries.

Each crew will provide at the registration office the measurement certificate of the Tempest. Sailing instructions will be available upon registration. For bank transfer, call the secretariat to get the CNSR bank account IBAN number. All banks charges are to be covered by the competitor.

The entry fee is: 90 euros per boat / 50 € for team under 25 years.

## 5.- Publicity

The annexe 1 catégorie C of the code ISAF will be apply.

## 6.- Scoring

The number of race to constitute a series is: 3.

The "low point scoring system" as per Appendix A will apply.

Four races are scheduled Saturday 7, five races Sunday 8 and three races Monday 9.

### 7.- Prize giving ceremony

Prize giving ceremony Monday 9th April at 17h00 on Club Nautique de Saint-Raphaël.

## 8.- Mooring, car park, craning and responsability

Parking for trailers and cars will be in places made available to the competitors. The CNSR will not assure any surveillance and this parking is solely the responsibility of the owners. Craning is offered for boats allowed to be craned. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risks. Decision to race or to continue racing is their own responsibility. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

#### 9.- Insurance

Each foreign competitor without FFVoile license shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1 500 000 €.
